Think Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Costs Scholarship

- Assists with associated costs for studies.

Think Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Tuition Scholarship

- Assists with 50% of tuition costs for a Diploma or Undergraduate course.

Overview of Scholarships

- Identify as an Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person.
- Enrolled as a student at Think Education
- Demonstrate financial hardship.
- Ability to maintain satisfactory academic performance.
- Not in receipt of similar financial scholarship support
