Entry requirements

Learners must satisfy *one* of the entry requirements below:

Academic qualifications

Successful completion of an undergraduate degree in any field, or equivalent.

OR

Work and life experience

Applicants without formal qualifications are eligible to apply if they have seven years of professional, administrative or managerial work experience. Applications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Individuals will need to be sponsored by a workplace that can appropriately support them by providing a significant contemporary project and appropriate resourcing.
